







District One Volunteer Codes of Conduct

As a representative of the District One office, you are expected to:

- 1. Be responsible for your own behavior/conduct and maintain high standards.
- 2. Make an active effort to uphold the values and work ethics of the District One Office.
- 3. Behave appropriately and professionally at community events.
- 4. Show respect for, and cooperate with fellow group and community members, volunteers/interns, staff, including their opinions.
- 5. Use appropriate language; avoid name calling, insults, and other inappropriate verbal or non-verbal conduct likely to offend, hurt, or set a bad example.
- 6. Avoid taking part in any circumstances which involve the belittling or bullying of another group member and report such acts to authority.
- 7. Support and abide by rules and expectations set by authoritative figures.
- 8. Actively and respectfully participate in group activities.
- 9. Be cautious of content you post on social media sites (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Nextdoor, etc.). Inappropriate postings regarding any District One related activities, volunteers, or personnel will not be tolerated. You may be asked to leave the group and lose service hours.
- 10. Respect the values, beliefs, and boundaries of peers and staff.
- 11. Come prepared and ready to work on the task at hand.
- 12. Refrain from participating in any activities that have not been authorized by staff.
- 13. Report any type of misconduct to authority.
- 14. A volunteer determined to be in possession of, or under the influence of, illegal substances is subject to immediate discharge. The District One Office has the right to report such incidences to the volunteer's school, parents, and/or further authorities.
